9	AN ACT concerning the Kansas state school for the blind; relating to the
10	rates of compensation for teachers employed thereby.
11	
12	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
13	Section 1. On and after July 1, 2005, each person employed by the
14	Kansas state school for the blind as a teacher, as defined by K.S.A. 76-
15	11a04 and amendments thereto, shall be paid compensation for such em-
16	ployment at a rate that is not less than the rate of compensation that is
17	paid to a teacher employed by unified school district no. 233, Olathe,
18	Kansas, who has comparable or substantially the same levels of education
19	and experience as the person employed by the Kansas state school for

20 the blind or, if no such teacher is employed by such school district during

21 that time period, then such person employed by the Kansas state school

22 for the blind shall be paid compensation at a rate that is not less than the

23 rate of compensation that would be paid to such a teacher employed by

24 unified school district no. 233, Olathe, Kansas, during such time period.

25 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 26 publication in the statute book.
