9 AN ACT supplementing the Kansas consumer protection code; concern-10ing dissemination of electronic mail addresses; prohibiting certain acts 11and providing remedies and penalties for violations. 1213 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. (a) A person sponsoring, arranging or conducting a con-15 ference, seminar or other meeting shall not disseminate any electronic 16 mail address received in the course of registration for such conference, seminar or other meeting without the express authorization of the 1718registrant. 19(b) Violation of this section is a deceptive act or practice under the 20provisions of the Kansas consumer protection act and shall be subject to 21any and all enforcement provisions of the Kansas consumer protection 22 act. 23 Any person alleging a violation of the provisions of this section (c) 24 may bring a private action to seek relief pursuant to K.S.A. 50-634, 50-25636 and this section, and amendments thereto, and such person may be 26 defined as a consumer pursuant to K.S.A. 50-624, and amendments 27 thereto, for the purposes of such private action. 28(d) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas con-29 sumer protection act. 30 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 31publication in the statute book.
