9 AN ACT concerning employment and labor; relating to overtime pay. 10 11 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* 12 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "overtime 13 protection act." 14Sec. 2. (a) Federal regulations which took effect August 23, 2004, 15 make it easier for employers to classify their employees as exempt from 16 overtime pay. As many as 6,000,000 workers in a wide variety of jobs may 17lose the right to overtime pay as a result of these regulations. 18The purpose of this act is to preserve the rights of affected work-(b) 19ers to overtime pay in this state. 20Sec. 3. (a) Regulations promulgated by the United States depart-21ment of labor at 29 C.F.R. Part 541, effective on August 23, 2004, which 22 revised regulations governing the exemption from overtime pay for ex-23 ecutive, administrative, professional, outside sales and certain computer 24 employees in effect prior to August 23, 2004, shall apply to such employ-25ees employed in this state as follows: 26(1) Any employee who would have had the right to earn overtime pay 27under the federal regulations in effect on August 22, 2004, but who would 28 lose the right to earn overtime pay under the federal regulations in effect 29 on and after August 23, 2004, shall continue to have such person's eligi-30 bility for overtime pay determined under the regulations in effect on 31 August 22, 2004. 32 (2)The minimum salary an employer must pay an employee before 33 that employee can lose the right to overtime shall be the salary set forth 34 at 29 C.F.R. section 541.600 as that provision was revised effective August 35 23, 2004, or as it may be revised from time to time in the future by the 36 United States secretary of labor. 37 (b) The state secretary of labor shall promulgate such regulations as 38 are necessary to enforce this act. 39 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 40publication in the statute book.
