9 AN ACT concerning the Kansas sports hall of fame; relating to funding 10 thereof; providing for the use of certain lottery revenues therefor; amending K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 74-8711 and repealing the existing 11 12section. 13 14Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 15New Section 1. (a) The Kansas lottery commission shall designate 16lottery games the revenues from which shall be used for the purposes 17provided by this act. The commission shall designate such games so that at all times the proceeds of one, and only one, such game are used for 1819such purposes. 20(b) On or before the 15th day of each month, the executive director 21shall certify to the director of accounts and reports the amount of revenue 22 collected from the sale of lottery tickets and shares during the preceding 23 month from lottery games designated pursuant to subsection (a), less 24 amounts described in subsections (c)(1), (c)(2) and (c)(3) of K.S.A. 74-258711, and amendments thereto, which are attributable to such games. 26Upon receipt of the certification, the director of accounts and reports 27 shall transfer the amount so certified from the lottery operating fund to 28the Kansas sports hall of fame lottery fund established by section 2, and 29 amendments thereto. 30 New Sec. 2. (a) There is hereby established in the state treasury the 31Kansas sports hall of fame lottery fund. 32 On or before the 10th of each month, the director of accounts (b) 33 and reports shall transfer from the state general fund to the Kansas sports 34 hall of fame lottery fund interest earnings based on: 35 The average daily balance of moneys in the Kansas sports hall of (1)36 fame lottery fund for the preceding month; and 37 (2)the net earnings rate for the pooled money investment portfolio 38 for the preceding month. 39 (c) All expenditures from the Kansas sports hall of fame lottery fund 40 shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the 41director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved 42by the Kansas sports hall of fame board of trustees or by a person or 43 persons designated by the Kansas sports hall of fame board of trustees.

Section 3. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 74-8711 is hereby amended to read as
 follows: 74-8711. (a) There is hereby established in the state treasury the
 lottery operating fund.

(b) Except as provided by K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 74-8724, and amend-4 ments thereto, the executive director shall remit all moneys collected 5from the sale of lottery tickets and shares and any other moneys received 6 7 by or on behalf of the Kansas lottery to the state treasurer in accordance 8 with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon 9 receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the lottery operating fund. 10 Moneys credited to the fund shall be expended or transferred only as 11 12provided by this act. Expenditures from such fund shall be made in ac-13 cordance with appropriations acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the executive 1415director or by a person designated by the executive director.

(c) Moneys in the lottery operating fund shall be used for:

(1) The payment of expenses of the lottery, which shall include all 1718costs incurred in the operation and administration of the Kansas lottery; 19all costs resulting from contracts entered into for the purchase or lease 20of goods and services needed for operation of the lottery, including but 21not limited to supplies, materials, tickets, independent studies and sur-22 veys, data transmission, advertising, printing, promotion, incentives, pub-23 lic relations, communications and distribution of tickets and shares; and reimbursement of costs of facilities and services provided by other state 24 25agencies;

(2) the payment of compensation to lottery retailers;

(3) transfers of moneys to the lottery prize payment fund pursuant to
K.S.A. 74-8712, and amendments thereto;

29 (4) transfers to the state general fund pursuant to K.S.A. 74-8713, 30 and amendments thereto;

(5) transfers to the Kansas sports hall of fame lottery fund pursuant
to section 1, and amendments thereto;

(6) transfers to the state gaming revenues fund pursuant to subsection
(d) of this section and as otherwise provided by law; and

41 (1) An amount equal to the moneys in the lottery operating fund in 42 excess of those needed for the purposes described in subsections (c)(1)

43 through $\frac{(c)(4)}{(c)(5)}$; or

(2) except for pull-tab lottery tickets and shares, an amount equal to 1 not less than 30% of total monthly revenues from the sales of lottery 2 tickets and shares less estimated returned tickets. In the case of pull-tab 3 lottery tickets and shares, an amount equal to not less than 20% of the 4 total monthly revenues from the sales of pull-tab lottery tickets and shares $\mathbf{5}$ less estimated returned tickets. 6 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 74-8711 is hereby repealed. 7 Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 8
