Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) On and after the effective date of this act, no governing body of any city of this state shall adopt an ordinance or enter into a contract or other agreement which requires any person contracting or entering into an agreement with the city, or any instrumentality of the city, to pay wages to the employees of such person in excess of the federal minimum hourly wage or state minimum hourly wage.

- (b) On and after the effective date of this act, no board of county commissioners of any county of this state shall adopt a resolution or enter into a contract or other agreement which requires any person contracting or entering into an agreement with the county, or any instrumentality of the county, to pay wages to the employees of such person in excess of the federal minimum hourly wage or state minimum hourly wage.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
