Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a retailer licensed in this state may purchase and receive shipment of any wine, otherwise available in this state, from a person licensed to sell wine in another state if the retailer is unable to obtain such wine from a distributor licensed in this state.

- (b) A retailer purchasing and receiving shipment of wine as authorized by this section shall collect all taxes imposed with regard to such wine pursuant to K.S.A. 41-501, and amendments thereto, in accordance with rules and regulations of the secretary.
- (c) The secretary may adopt rules and regulations to implement and enforce the provisions of this section.
- This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas liquor control act.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
