9 AN ACT amending and supplementing the Kansas consumer protection 10 act; relating to call centers; prohibiting certain acts and providing remedies for violations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) As used in this section, "call center" means an operation which utilizes telecommunication services in one or more of the following activities: Providing customer service, providing government services, soliciting sales of property or services to the person called, soliciting extensions of credit to the person called, obtaining information to be used in soliciting sales or extensions of credit to the person called, reactivating dormant accounts, conducting surveys or research, collecting receivables, taking reservations or orders or soliciting charitable or political donations.

- (b) A person answering a call to or making a call from a call center, upon request by the person from whom such call is received or to whom such call is made, shall disclose the country where the call center is located.
- (c) Violation of subsection (b) is a deceptive and unconscionable act or practice under the provisions of the Kansas consumer protection act and shall be subject to any and all enforcement provisions of the Kansas consumer protection act.
- (d) Violation of subsection (b) by refusal to disclose the country where a call center is located shall render the violator liable for a civil penalty of 5,000 for each violation instead of the penalty provided for in subsection (a) of K.S.A. 50-636, and amendments thereto. Violation of subsection (b) by misrepresentation of the country where a call center is located shall render the violator liable for a civil penalty of 20,000 for each violation instead of the penalty provided for in subsection (a) of K.S.A. 50-636, and amendments thereto.
- (e) Any person alleging a violation of subsection (b) may bring a private action to seek relief pursuant to K.S.A. 50-634, 50-636 and this section, and amendments thereto, and such person may be defined as a consumer pursuant to K.S.A. 50-624, and amendments thereto, for the purposes of such private action.

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- (f) For purposes of enforcement of this section pursuant to subsection (d) or (e), the owner and the operator of the call center, and anyone 2 3 contracting for the services of the call center, shall be liable for a violation 4 of subsection (b).
- (g) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas con-6 sumer protection act.
 - Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
