## HOUSE BILL No. 2504

9 AN ACT concerning retirement and pensions; relating to the Kansas po-10 lice and firemen's retirement system; affiliation and membership; 11 contributions. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. (a) On July 1, 2005, the Kansas department of revenue, 15the Kansas department of wildlife and parks, the office of state fire mar-16shal, the office of the securities commissioner of Kansas, the Kansas rac-17ing and gaming commission and the Kansas department of corrections 18shall affiliate with the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system es-19tablished pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 74-4951 et seq., and amend-20ments thereto, pursuant to this act for membership in the system of per-21sons described in subsection (c), who have successfully completed the 22 required course of instruction for law enforcement officers approved by 23 the Kansas law enforcement training center and are certified pursuant to 24 the provisions of K.S.A. 74-5607a, and amendments thereto. For pur-25poses of such affiliation for membership in the system, such agencies and 26commissions shall be considered as new participating employers. Such 27agencies and commissions shall make application for affiliation with such 28 system in the manner provided by K.S.A. 74-4954, and amendments 29 thereto, to be effective on July 1 of the next year following such appli-30 cation. Such agencies and commissions shall affiliate for membership in 31 such system for such members for participating service credit. 32 Such agencies and commissions shall appropriate and pay a sum (b) 33 sufficient to satisfy any obligations as certified by the board of trustees of 34 the retirement system. The employer contributions of such agencies and 35 commissions shall be as provided in K.S.A. 74-4967, and amendments 36 thereto. 37 (c) Each person employed by the Kansas department of wildlife and 38 parks as a conservation officer I, conservation officer II, conservation 39 officer park ranger or law enforcement supervisor; the Kansas department 40 of revenue as a liquor control investigator or enforcement agent; the office 41of fire marshal as a fire investigation supervisor fire investigator; the rac-42ing and gaming commission as an enforcement agent; the office of the 43 securities commissioner of Kansas as a securities special investigator I,

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1 securities special investigator II, securities special investigator III and securities special investigator IV and director of enforcement; and the 2 department of corrections as a parole supervisor, parole officer I and 3 parole officer II on the date of affiliation, may become a member of the 4 Kansas police and firemen's retirement system for participating service  $\mathbf{5}$ credit only on the first day of the payroll period of such person, coinciding 6 7 with or following the entry date of the person's participating employer as provided in this section, only by filing with the board of trustees of the 8 9 system, on or before the entry date of the person's participating employer to become a member of the system. Failure to file such written election 10 shall be presumed to be an election not to become a member of the 11 12system. Such election, whether to become or not to become a member, 13 shall be irrevocable.

Each person employed by such participating employers who is on 14(d) 15 an authorized leave of absence or is in the military service on the entry 16date of the person's participating employer as provided in this section may become a member of the Kansas police and firemen's retirement 1718system on the day of the first payroll period of such person, coinciding 19with such person's return to active employment and payroll, only by filing 20with the board of trustees of the system within 10 days after such return 21to active employment a written election to become a member of the 22system. Failure to file such written election shall be presumed to be an 23 election not to become a member of the system. Such election, whether to become a member or not to become a member, shall be irrevocable. 24

(e) Every person who is employed by such participating employer on
or after the entry date of the person's participating employer into the
Kansas police and firemen's retirement system as provided in this section
shall become a member of the Kansas police and firemen's retirement
system on the first day of such employment.

(f) Any participating employer that affiliates as provided in this act
and each person who elects to become a member as provided in this act
or who becomes a member as provided in subsection (e) shall be subject
to the provisions of K.S.A. 74-4951 et seq., and amendments thereto, as
applicable.

(g) The division of the budget and the governor shall include in the budget and in the budget request for appropriations for personnel services the amount required to satisfy the employer's obligation under this act as certified by the board of trustees of the system, and shall present the same to the legislature for allowance and appropriations.

(h) The determination of retirement, death or disability benefits shall
be computed upon the basis of "credited service" as used in K.S.A. 744951 et seq., and amendments thereto, but shall include only participating
service with the person's participating employer, commencing on and

- 2 the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system.
- 3 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its4 publication in the Kansas register.
