## **HOUSE Substitute for SENATE BILL No. 1**

9 AN ACT concerning bioscience; creating the joint committee on biosci-10 ence oversight. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. (a) There is hereby created the joint committee on bio-14science oversight within the legislative branch of state government. The 15joint committee shall be composed of 12 members. Six members shall be 16members of the house of representatives and six members shall be mem-17bers of the senate. Four of the members who are members of the house 18of representatives shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of rep-19resentatives, four members who are senators shall be appointed by the 20president of the senate, two members who are members of the house of 21representatives shall be appointed by the minority leader of the house of 22 representatives and two members who are senators shall be appointed by 23 the minority leader of the senate. 24 All members of the joint committee on bioscience oversight shall (b) 25serve for terms of two years ending on the first day of the regular session 26of the legislature commencing in the first odd-numbered year after the 27year of appointment, except that the first members shall be appointed on 28July 1, 2006, and shall serve for terms ending on the first day of the regular 29 session of the legislature commencing in 2007. If a vacancy occurs in the 30 office of any member of the joint committee on bioscience oversight, a 31successor shall be appointed in the same manner as the original appoint-32 ment for the remainder of the term. 33 (c) (1) The chairperson of the joint committee on bioscience over-34 sight shall be appointed for a term of one year which ends on the first 35 day of the next occurring regular session of the legislature. The speaker 36 of the house of representatives shall appoint the first chairperson on July 37 1, 2006, and shall appoint the chairperson for the term commencing on 38 the first day of the regular session of the legislature commencing in 2007 39 for a one-year term to end on the first day of the regular session of the 40 legislature commencing in the year 2008. The president of the senate 41shall appoint the next chairperson on the first day of the regular session 42of the legislature commencing in the year 2007 for a one-year term which 43 ends on the first day of the next occurring regular session of the legisla1 ture. Thereafter the appointment of the chairperson shall continue to 2 alternate between the speaker of the house of representatives and the 3 president of the senate with each subsequent chairperson being ap-4 pointed for a one-year term ending on the first day of the regular session 5 of the legislature in the next occurring regular session of the legislature 6 after the year of appointment.

7 (2)The vice-chairperson of the joint committee on bioscience over-8 sight shall be appointed for a term of one year which ends on the first 9 day of the next occurring regular session of the legislature. The president of the senate shall appoint the first vice-chairperson on July 1, 2006, and 10shall appoint the vice-chairperson for the term commencing on the first 11 12day of the regular session of the legislature commencing in 2007 for a one-year term to end on the first day of the regular session of the legis-13 lature commencing in the year 2008. The speaker of the house of rep-1415resentatives shall appoint the next vice-chairperson on the first day of the 16regular session of the legislature commencing in the year 2008 for a oneyear term which ends on the first day of the next occurring regular session 1718of the legislature. Thereafter the appointment of the vice-chairperson 19shall continue to alternate between the speaker of the house of represen-20tatives and the president of the senate with each subsequent vice-chair-21person being appointed for a one-year term ending on the first day of the 22 regular session of the legislature in the next occurring regular session of 23 the legislature after the year of appointment.

(3) If a vacancy occurs in the office of the chairperson or vice-chairperson, a member of the joint committee on bioscience oversight who is a member of the same house of the legislature as the member who vacated the office shall be appointed by the speaker of the house, if the vacating member was a member of the house of representatives, or by the president of the senate, if the vacating member was a member of the senate, to fill such vacancy.

(d) A quorum of the joint committee on bioscience oversight shall be
seven. All actions of the joint committee on bioscience oversight shall be
taken by a majority of all of the members of the joint committee.

(e) The joint committee on bioscience oversight shall have the au-thority to meet at any time and at any place within the state on the callof the chairperson.

(f) The provisions of the acts contained in article 12 of chapter 46 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, applicable to special committees shall apply to the joint committee on bioscience oversight to the extent that the same do not conflict with the specific provisions of this section applicable to the joint committee.

42 (g) Members of the joint committee on bioscience oversight shall 43 receive compensation, travel expenses and subsistence expenses as provided in K.S.A. 75-3212, and amendments thereto, when attending meet ings of the joint committee.

3 (h) The staff of the legislative research department, the office of re-4 visor of statutes and the division of legislative administrative services shall 5 provide such assistance as may be requested by the joint committee on 6 bioscience oversight and to the extent authorized by the legislative co-7 ordinating council.

8 (i) The joint committee on bioscience oversight shall have the exclu-9 sive responsibility to monitor and study the operations and decisions of 10 the Kansas bioscience authority.

(j) In accordance with K.S.A. 46-1204, and amendments thereto, the
legislative coordinating council may provide for such professional services
as may be requested by the joint committee on bioscience oversight.

14 (k) The joint committee on bioscience oversight may introduce such15 legislation as it deems necessary in performing its functions.

16 (l) The provisions of this section shall expire on July 1, 2014.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the statute book.
