9 AN ACT concerning the Kansas insurance score act; relating to penalties 10for violations thereof; amending K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 40-5112 and re-11pealing the existing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 40-5112 is hereby amended to read as 1415follows: 40-5112. Whenever an insurer is found to be in violation of any provision of this act, the commissioner shall proceed under K.S.A. 40-16 2,125 and amendments thereto. (a) Any violation of this act shall also be 1718considered an unfair or deceptive act or practice under K.S.A. 40-2404, 19 and amendments thereto, and subject to the penalties contained in K.S.A. 2040-2401 et seq., and amendments thereto. 21(b) Any violation of this act is a deceptive and unconscionable act or 22 practice under the provisions of the Kansas consumer protection act and 23 shall be subject to any and all of the enforcement provisions of the Kansas 24 consumer protection act. 25(c) Any person alleging a violation of this act may bring a private 26 action to seek relief pursuant to K.S.A. 50-634, 50-636 and this section, 27 and amendments thereto, and such person may be defined as a consumer 28 pursuant to K.S.A. 50-624, and amendments thereto, for the purposes of 29 such private action. 30 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 40-5112 is hereby repealed. Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 3132 publication in the statute book.
