9 AN ACT concerning children and minors; relating to licensure of a child 10 care facility or family day care home.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The secretary of health and environment shall permanently deny, revoke or refuse to renew a certificate of registration or temporary permit issued under the provisions of K.s.A. 65-501 through 65-522, and amendments thereto, wherein the secretary determines that a licensed child care provider knowingly left children age 16 or under in the care of a nonlicensed child care provider while such licensed child care provider was absent from the premises and abuse to a child occurred and the charge of abuse was then validated by the department of social and rehabilitation services.

(b) This section shall be part of and supplemental to article 5 of chapter 65 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
