AN ACT concerning the teacher service scholarship program; amending 10K.S.A. 74-32,101 and 74-32,102 and repealing the existing sections. 11 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 74-32,101 is hereby amended to read as follows: 141574-32,101. As used in this act: 16(a) "Executive officer" means the chief executive officer of the state board of regents appointed under K.S.A. 74-3203a, and amendments 1718thereto: 19"qualified student" means a person who: (1) Is a resident of the (b) state of Kansas; (2) has been accepted for admission to or is enrolled full 2021time in a course of instruction leading to eertification licensure as a 22 teacher; and (3) has qualified for the award of a scholarship under the 23 teacher service scholarship program on the basis of having demonstrated 24 scholastic ability, or who has previously so qualified and remains qualified 25for renewal of the scholarship on the basis of remaining in good standing 26 and making satisfactory progress toward completion of the requirements 27 of the course of instruction in which enrolled; 28(c) "hard-to-fill teaching discipline" means (1) a teaching discipline 29 in which there is a critical shortage of teachers as determined and spec-30 ified by the state board of education; and (2) the teaching disciplines of 31 mathematics and science for any of the grades six five through 12; 32 "underserved area" means a geographic area of the state in which (d) 33 there is a critical shortage of teachers as determined and specified by the 34 state board of education-; 35 "state educational institution" has the meaning ascribed thereto (e)36 in K.S.A. 76-711, and amendments thereto; 37 (f)"private postsecondary educational institution" has the meaning 38 ascribed thereto in K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 72-34,163 74-32,163, and amend-39 ments thereto. 40K.S.A. 74-32,102 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-Sec. 2. 32,102. (a) There is hereby established the teacher service scholarship 4142program. A scholarship may be awarded under the teacher service schol-43 arship program to any qualified student and may be renewed for each

1 such student who remains qualified for the scholarship. Determination 2 of the students qualified for such scholarships shall be made by the ex-3 ecutive officer. Scholastic ability shall be determined on the basis of any 4 one or more of the following: (1) High ACT or SAT score; (2) rank in high school graduation class; (3) cumulative high school or college grade $\mathbf{5}$ 6 point average; or (4) any other indicator of scholastic ability which the 7 state board of regents determines to be demonstrative of potential for 8 successful completion of a course of instruction leading to eertification 9 licensure as a teacher. To the extent practicable and consistent with qualification factors, preference shall be given to qualified students who 10have been accepted for admission to or are enrolled in an approved course 11 12of instruction leading to certification as a teacher in the disciplines of 13 mathematics or science for any of the grades six through 12. In addition, 14consideration shall be given to *qualified* students who are members of 15ethnic minority groups. 16A scholarship awarded under the program shall provide for pay-(b) 17ment to a qualified student of (1) an amount not to exceed 70% of the 18cost of attendance for an academic year at the teacher education school 19in which the qualified student is enrolled if such teacher education school 20is maintained by a state educational institution or (2) an amount not to 21exceed 70% of the average amount of the cost of attendance for an aca-22 demic year at the teacher education schools maintained by the state ed-23 ucational institutions if the teacher education school in which the quali-24 fied student is enrolled is not a state educational institution in a private 25postsecondary educational institution located in the state of Kansas. A 26qualified student may be awarded a scholarship for not more than four 27academic years of undergraduate study, except that a qualified student 28who is enrolled full time in a course of instruction leading to certification 29 *licensure* in a teaching discipline for which graduate study is required 30 may be awarded a scholarship for the duration of the course of instruction. 31 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 74-32,101 and 74-32,102 are hereby repealed. 32 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 33 publication in the statute book.
