SENATE BILL No. 46

 $\begin{array}{cccc} \text{AN ACT concerning canceled state warrants; relating to fees for reissuance;} \\ \text{amending K.S.A. 46-921 and repealing the existing section.} \end{array}$

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 46-921 is hereby amended to read as follows: 46-921. The director of accounts and reports is authorized to make payment to any claimant entitled thereto for a claim on a warrant which was canceled under K.S.A. 10-811 and amendments thereto. Entitlement to claim payment on a canceled warrant shall expire four years from the date of cancellation. Any such payment shall be in the amount denoted on the canceled warrant less 10% thereof or \$15 not to exceed \$30, whichever amount is more less. All claims under this section shall be paid from the canceled warrants payment fund under K.S.A. 10-812 and amendments thereto.

- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 46-921 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
