9 AN ACT concerning hunting; relating to hunter's education require-10 ments; amending K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 32-920 and repealing the existing 11 section. 1213Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 32-920 is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 32-920. (a) Except as provided by subsection (e), no person who 16is born on or after July 1, 1957, and is 16 or more years of age shall hunt 17in this state on land other than such person's own land unless the person 18has been issued a certificate of completion of an approved hunter edu-19cation course. If such person is required by law to obtain a hunting li-20cense, the person shall attest to or exhibit proof of completion of such 21course to the person issuing the license at the time of purchasing the 22 license. If such person is not required by law to obtain a hunting license, 23 is less than 27 years of age but 16 or more years of age or is less than 16 24 but 12 or more years of age and hunting without adult supervision, the 25person shall be in possession of the person's certificate of completion of 26such course while hunting. A person may purchase for another person, 27under rules and regulations adopted by the secretary in accordance with 28 K.S.A. 32-805 and amendments thereto, a lifetime hunting or combina-29 tion hunting and fishing license without the license recipient's first having 30 been issued a certificate of completion of an approved hunter education 31 course. 32 (b) A person less than 12 years of age shall not hunt unless under the 33 direct supervision of an adult who is 18 or more years of age. 34 (c) A person who is 12 or more years of age but less than 16 years of 35 age and who has not been issued a certificate of completion of an ap-36 proved hunter education course shall not hunt unless under the direct 37 supervision of an adult who is 18 or more years of age. 38 (d) A person less than 14 years of age shall not be issued a permit to 39 take big game using a bow unless the person submits to the secretary 40 evidence satisfactory to the secretary of completion of a bow hunting 41safety education course. 42Prior to July 1, 2005, Completion of an approved hunter education (e) 43 course shall not be required to obtain a special controlled shooting area SB 98

1 hunting license valid only for licensed controlled shooting areas.
