## **Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 1602**

12 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the appointment of a task 13 force to study the licensing and appointment process for insurance 14 agents.

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WHEREAS, The Kansas State Legislature created the Kansas Insurance Department in 1871; and

WHEREAS, The Kansas Insurance Department has established an agent licensing and appointment process; and

WHEREAS, Federal law may soon supersede current Kansas law requiring the Kansas Insurance Department to change the current agent licensing and appointment process; and

WHEREAS, The Kansas Insurance Department may need to request legislative changes to the Kansas Insurance Laws to be compliant: Now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Kansas, the House of Representatives concurring therein: That a task force be formed consisting of 14 17 members to include the chair, vice-chair and ranking minority of the senate committee on financial institutions and insurance; the chair, vice-chair and ranking minority of the house committee on insurance, the insurance commissioner or the commissioner's designee, one person representing a health insurance plan appointed by the insurance commissioner from a list submitted by the Kansas association of **health plans**, one person representing a domestic property and casualty insurance company appointed by the insurance commissioner from a list submitted by the Kansas Association of Property and Casualty Insurance Companies, one person representing a domestic life or health insurance company appointed by the insurance commissioner from a list submitted by the Kansas life and health insurance association, one person representing foreign stock insurance companies appointed by the insurance commissioner from a list submitted by the American Insurance Association, one person representing foreign insurance companies appointed by the insurance commissioner from a list submitted by the Prop22

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1 erty Casualty Insurance Association of America, one person representing 2 a property and casualty insurance company appointed by the insurance 3 commissioner from a list submitted by the National Association of Mutual Insurance Companies, one person representing a life insurance com-4 pany appointed by the insurance commissioner from a list submit-6 ted by the American council of life insurers, one member representing Kansas insurance agents appointed by the insurance commissioner from 8 a list submitted by the Kansas Association of Insurance and Financial 9 Advisors and two members representing the licensed Kansas insurance agents appointed by the insurance commissioner from a list submitted by 10 the Kansas Association of Insurance Agents. The commissioner shall ap-11 12 point the chairperson and the vice-chairperson from the membership of 13 the committee. The chairperson and the vice-chairperson shall not be of the same political party. Legislative members serving on the task force 14 15 shall receive pay and allowances as provided for legislative service. No other Other task force members shall receive any compensation, subsis-16 tence, mileage or other allowances be paid subsistence allowances and 17 18 mileage as provided in K.S.A. 75-3223, and amendments thereto, 19 [No other task force members shall receive any compensation, sub-20 **sistence**, **mileage or other allowances**] for serving on the task force or 21 attending any meeting thereof.

Be it further resolved: That the task force shall be charged to recommend changes to the Kansas uniform agents licensing act by a majority vote if the task force finds any changes to be necessary.

Be it further resolved: That the task force shall be staffed by the appropriate members of the legislative research department and the office of the revisor of statutes.

Be it further resolved: That the task force shall submit a final report to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house and the commissioner of insurance by January 1, 2006.
