12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

13 Section 1. (a) As used in this section, "length of service" means total time worked in the classified service or unclassified service under the 14 15Kansas civil service act, including time spent on an appointment to a 16 position pursuant to K.S.A. 75-2935(1)(i), and amendments thereto. Length of service does not include time worked as: (1) A temporary em-17ployee; (2) a student employed by an institution under the state board of 18regents; (3) a resident worker in any institution under the secretary of 19 20 social and rehabilitation services or the Kansas commission on veterans 21affairs; or (4) an inmate of any correctional institution or facility under 22control of the secretary of corrections. 23 Except as provided in subsection (c), an increase in the rate of (b) 24 vacation leave earnings based on length of service shall not be retroactive. 25(c) If an error occurs in computing an employee's length of service

and such error would deny the employee vacation leave earnings to which the employee would otherwise have been entitled if the error had not occurred, such employee's vacation leave earnings shall be increased to reflect correction of the error.

30 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 31 publication in the statute book.
