AN ACT concerning the Kansas offender registration act; relating to residency restrictions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) It shall be unlawful for an offender to reside within 1,000 feet of a licensed child care facility or registered family day care home or 1,500 feet of the real property of any school upon which is located a structure used by a unified school district or an accredited non-public school for student instruction or attendance or extracurricular activities of pupils enrolled in kindergarten or any grades one through 12.

- (b) Violation of this section is a class A nonperson misdemeanor.
- (c) This section shall not apply to any of the following:
- (1) An offender who is serving a sentence at any state correctional institution or facility, conservation camp, state security hospital, juvenile correctional facility, community correction center or facility for detention or confinement, juvenile detention facility or jail.
- (2) An offender who is subject to an order of commitment pursuant to K.S.A. 59-29a01 et seq., and amendments thereto.
- (3) An offender who has established a residence prior to July 1, 2006, or a school, licensed child care facility or registered family day care home is newly located on or after July 1, 2006.
  - (4) An offender who is a minor or a ward under a guardianship.
  - (d) For purposes of this section:
- (1) "Offender" means a person who is an offender as defined in K.S.A. 22-4902, and amendments thereto, and the criminal conviction which requires the offender to register was against a victim or involved a party who was less than 18 years of age.
- (2) "Residence" means the place where a person sleeps, which may include more than one location, and may be mobile or transitory.
- (e) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas offender registration act.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
