Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2006, as part of the Kansas medicaid home and community based services program, payroll agents for clients who self-direct their own care services shall be selected through a process established by the agency administering such a program.

- (b) (1) Under the Kansas medicaid home and community based services program, family members of clients who self-direct their own care services may provide services to such clients but shall not be reimbursed more than 75% of the regular reimbursement rate for such services. To be eligible for reimbursement the family member must be 18 years of age or older.
- As used in this subsection, "family members" means: (2)
 - A parent, child or sibling;
- 26 a sibling, as denoted by the prefix "half";
- 27 (C) a parent, child or sibling, as denoted by the prefix "step";
- 28 (D) a foster child;
- 29 (\mathbf{E}) an uncle, aunt, nephew or niece;
- 30 any parent or child of a preceding or subsequent generation, as (F) 31 denoted by the prefix of "grand" or "great"; or
- 32 a parent, child or sibling related by marriage as denoted by the 33 suffix of "in-law."
- 34 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
