12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

13 Section 1. Whenever the state board of education determines that a school has failed to meet the accreditation requirements established by 1415rules and regulations or standards adopted by the state board or is not 16 providing the curriculum required by state law, the state board shall so 17notify the school district in which the school is located. In such notice, 18the state board shall specify the accreditation requirements the school 19 has failed to meet and the curriculum required by state law that the school 20has failed to provide. Upon receipt of such notification, the board of 21education of such district shall allocate sufficient resources to remedy all 22 deficiencies identified by the state board. 23 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

24 publication in the statute book.
