HOUSE BILL No. 2574

AN ACT concerning the state board of regents; relating to the disposition of property acquired by devise; amending K.S.A. 74-3254 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 74-3254 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-3254. The state board of regents is hereby authorized to sell and convey or otherwise dispose of any devise received by said the board or a state educational institution subject to its supervision and control without further legislative authorization, subject to any conditions imposed by the testator, where the interest of the state board of regents or such state education institution in the devise is one-half (1/2) or less of the total interest. The proceeds of any such sale and conveyance may be invested in accordance with K.S.A. 76-156a, and amendments thereto.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 74-3254 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
