9 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; concerning certain personal infor-10 mation required on certain documents; amending K.S.A. 8-131, 8-143e and 8-169 and repealing the existing sections. 11 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14New Section. 1. (a) An identification card or certificate of insurance 15issued to a policyholder by an insurer for the purpose of providing evidence of financial security under K.S.A. 40-3101, et seq., and amend-16 17ments thereto, shall not be printed with the address of the policy holder. The provisions of this section shall apply to identification cards or 18(b) 19certificates of insurance issued to policy holders on and after January 1, 202007. 21(c) The provisions of this section shall be a part of and supplemental 22 to the Kansas automobile injury reparations act. 23 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-131 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-131. (a) 24 Upon the filing of such application for registration, payment of the fees 25hereinafter provided, the division of vehicles shall register the vehicle and 26shall issue to the owner a registration receipt which shall contain upon 27 the face thereof the registration number assigned to the owner and to be 28used upon the vehicle, and such other statements of facts as may be 29 determined by the division, except that on and after January 1, 2007, the 30 registration receipt shall not be issued with the address of the owner. 31Sec. 3. K.S.A. 8-143e is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-143e. 32 The county treasurer shall issue to the owner a registration receipt on 33 each application for a truck or truck tractor license. The registration ap-34 plication and receipt shall be in such number and contain such information as the division shall determine, except that on and after January 1, 35 36 2007, the registration receipt shall not be issued with the address of the 37 owner. A copy of the registration receipt shall be carried in the cab of 38 such truck or truck tractor during all the time the same is operated on 39 the highways of this state. Any truck or truck tractor for which the owner 40 has declared the maximum gross weight to be more than twelve thousand 41(12,000) 12,000 pounds shall have painted or otherwise durably marked 42on said the vehicle on both sides thereof, in plain letters not less than two 43 (2) inches in height and with not less than <del>one-fourth (1/4) 1/4</del> inch stroke,

1 the gross weight for which said the vehicle is licensed, and the name and 2 address of the owner or lessee thereof: Provided,, except that if the di-3 vision shall find that any insignia or trademark painted or otherwise durably marked on any such vehicle is sufficient to properly show the gross 4 weight for which said the vehicle is licensed and to identify the owner  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 and show the address of the owner thereof, the division may issue a permit 7 authorizing the use of such insignia or trademark. Provided further, That. A vehicle registered as a farm truck or truck tractor shall not be required 8 9 to be so painted or marked. When such painting or marking shall become illegible, the same shall be repainted or remarked, as herein required. 10 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 8-169 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-169. 11 12Upon the filing of such application for registration and payment of the 13 fees hereinafter provided the division shall register the vehicle and shall issue to the owner a registration receipt in such form as the division shall 14 15 deem adequate, except that on and after January 1, 2007, a registration 16 receipt shall not be issued with the address of the owner. 17Sec. 5. K.S.A. 8-131, 8-143e and 8-169 are hereby repealed. 18Sec. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 19 publication in the statute book.
