9 AN ACT concerning retirement and pensions; relating to the Kansas public employees retirement system; employment after retirement; 10 amending K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 74-4914 and repealing the existing 11 12section. 13 14Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 15Section 1. K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 74-4914 is hereby amended to read as 16follows: 74-4914. (1) The normal retirement date for a member of the 17system shall be the first day of the month coinciding with or following 18termination of employment with any participating employer not followed 19by employment with any participating employer within 30 days and the 20attainment of age 65 or, commencing July 1, 1993, age 62 with the com-21pletion of 10 years of credited service or the first day of the month co-22 inciding with or following the date that the total of the number of years 23 of credited service and the number of years of attained age of the member 24 is equal to or more than 85. In no event shall a normal retirement date 25for a member be before six months after the entry date of the participating 26 employer by whom such member is employed. A member may retire on 27 the normal retirement date or on the first day of any month thereafter 28upon the filing with the office of the retirement system of an application 29 in such form and manner as the board shall prescribe. Nothing herein 30 shall prevent any person, member or retirant from being employed, ap-31pointed or elected as an employee, appointee, officer or member of the 32 legislature. Elected officers may retire from the system on any date on 33 or after the attainment of the normal retirement date, but no retirement 34 benefits payable under this act shall be paid until the member has ter-35 minated such member's office. 36 (2)No retirant shall make contributions to the system or receive serv-37 ice credit for any service after the date of retirement. 38 Any member who is an employee of an affiliating employer pur-(3)39 suant to K.S.A. 74-4954b and amendments thereto and has not withdrawn 40 such member's accumulated contributions from the Kansas police and 41firemen's retirement system may retire before such member's normal 42retirement date on the first day of any month coinciding with or following 43 the attainment of age 55.

1 (4) Any member may retire before such member's normal retirement 2 date on the first day of any month coinciding with or following termination 3 of employment with any participating employer not followed by employment with any participating employer within 30 days and the attainment 4 of age 55 with the completion of 10 years of credited service, but in no $\mathbf{5}$ event before six months after the entry date, upon the filing with the 6 7 office of the retirement system of an application for retirement in such form and manner as the board shall prescribe. 8 9 If a retirant who retired on or after July 1, 1988, is employed or (5)appointed in or to any position or office for which compensation for serv-10 ice is paid in an amount equal to \$15,000 or more, or commencing in 11 12calendar year 2006, and all calendar years thereafter, \$20,000 or more in 13 any one such calendar year, by any participating employer for which such retirant was employed or appointed during the final two years of such 1415 retirant's participation, such retirant shall not receive any retirement ben-16efit for any month for which such retirant serves in such position or office. The participating employer shall report to the system within 30 days of 1718when the compensation paid to the retirant is equal to or exceeds any 19limitation provided by this section. Any retirant employed by a partici-20pating employer shall not make contributions nor receive additional credit 21under such system for such service except as provided by this section. 22Upon request of the executive director of the system, the secretary of 23 revenue shall provide such information as may be needed by the executive director to carry out the provisions of this act. The provisions of this 24 25subsection shall not apply to retirants employed as substitute teachers or officers, employees or appointees of the legislature. The provisions of this 2627 subsection shall not apply to members of the legislature prior to January 28 8, 2000. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to any other 29 elected officials prior to the term of office of such elected official which 30 commences on or after July 1, 2000. The provisions of this subsection 31 shall apply to any other elected official on and after the term of office of 32 such other elected official which commences on or after July 1, 2000. 33 Except as otherwise provided, commencing January 8, 2001, the provi-34 sions of this subsection shall apply to members of the legislature. For 35 determination of the amount of compensation paid pursuant to this subsection, for members of the legislature, compensation shall include any 36 37 amount paid as provided pursuant to subsections (a), (b), (c) and (d) of 38 K.S.A. 46-137a, and amendments thereto, or pursuant to K.S.A. 46-137b, 39 and amendments thereto. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the 40 contrary, when a member of the legislature is paid an amount of compensation of \$15,000 or more in any one calendar year, the member may 41continue to receive any amount provided in subsections (b) and (d) of 42K.S.A. 46-137a, and amendments thereto, and still be entitled to receive 43

1 such member's retirement benefit. Commencing July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2008, the provisions of this subsection shall not apply to retirants 2 3 who either retired under the provisions of subsection (1), or, if they retired under the provisions of subsection (4), were retired more than 30 4 days prior to the effective date of this act and are licensed professional $\mathbf{5}$ nurses or licensed practical nurses employed by the state of Kansas at the 6 7 Osawatomie state hospital, Rainbow mental health facility, Larned state hospital, Parsons state hospital and training center, Kansas neurological 8 9 institute, the Kansas soldiers' home or the Kansas veterans' home. The participating employer of such retirant shall pay to the system the actu-10 arially determined employer contribution based on the retirant's com-11 pensation during any such period of employment. 1213 (6) For purposes of this section, any employee of a local governmental unit which has its own pension plan who becomes an employee of a 1415 participating employer as a result of a merger or consolidation of services provided by local governmental units, which occurred on January 1, 1994, 16 17may count service with such local governmental unit in determining whether such employee has met the years of credited service require-1819 ments contained in this section. Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 74-4914 is hereby repealed. 20
