Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 72-7601 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-7601. (a) The state board shall appoint a commissioner of education as is provided by section 4 of article 6 of the constitution. The commissioner shall serve at the pleasure of the state board and perform such duties as are prescribed by law or by the state board.

- (b) No person shall be appointed as commissioner of education unless such person holds a current license as a teacher or as a school administrator or has significant training or experience in the field of education or school administration.
- The state board may appoint a person to be the acting commissioner of education in any interim in which the office of commissioner of education is vacant, and such appointment may be made conditional upon any future vacancy occurring. Any appointment made under this subsection (b) shall be subject to review and change by the state board at its first meeting after any such vacancy occurs. A person may not serve as an acting commissioner of education for a period of time exceeding 12 months. An acting commissioner of education shall not be required to meet the qualifications of subsection (b).
