9 AN ACT concerning water districts; relating to the detachment of ter-10 ritory therefrom. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. (a) Words and phrases used in this section shall have the 14meanings ascribed thereto by K.S.A. 82a-612, and amendments thereto. 15(b) As a complete alternative to any other procedure provided by law 16for the detachment of land from a water district, land may be detached 17from a district as provided by this section. The owners of land located within a water district may file a petition requesting that land be detached 1819from such district. Such petition shall be filed with the county clerk and 20shall be signed by the owners of record of 70% or more of the land 21proposed to be detached or by 70% or more of the owners of record of 22 the land proposed to be detached. The county clerk shall notify the board 23 of the water district named in the petition that a detachment petition has 24 been filed. Within 30 days of the date on which such a petition is filed, 25the county clerk shall determine whether a petition is sufficient and shall 26so notify the board of county commissioners of such determination. If a 27 sufficient petition is filed, the board of county commissioners shall enter 28an order approving the petition for detachment. If an insufficient petition 29 is filed, the board of county commissioners shall enter an order rejecting 30 the petition for detachment. A copy of the order shall be sent to the water 31district board named in the detachment petition. A copy of such order 32 also shall be sent to the chief engineer. An order approving the petition 33 for detachment shall be effective on January 1 of the succeeding year. 34 Thereupon, the board, by resolution, shall declare the new boundaries of 35 the district and shall certify a copy of such resolution to the county clerk. 36 Any land detached from the district shall be liable for its propor-37 tionate share of all outstanding indebtedness of the district on the date 38 the order approving the detachment is entered by the board of county 39 commissioners. 40 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

41 publication in the statute book.
