## HOUSE BILL No. 2765

9 AN ACT concerning school finance; relating to at-risk pupils; amending 10K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 72-6407 and repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 72-6407 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-6407. (a) (1) "Pupil" means any person who is regularly en-1415 rolled in a district and attending kindergarten or any of the grades one 16 through 12 maintained by the district or who is regularly enrolled in a 17district and attending kindergarten or any of the grades one through 12 in another district in accordance with an agreement entered into under 18authority of K.S.A. 72-8233, and amendments thereto, or who is regularly 1920enrolled in a district and attending special education services provided 21for preschool-aged exceptional children by the district. 22 Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, (2)23 a pupil in attendance full time shall be counted as one pupil. A pupil in 24 attendance part time shall be counted as that proportion of one pupil (to 25the nearest  $\frac{1}{10}$  that the pupil's attendance bears to full-time attendance. 26A pupil attending kindergarten shall be counted as 1/2 pupil. A pupil en-27rolled in and attending an institution of postsecondary education which 28is authorized under the laws of this state to award academic degrees shall 29 be counted as one pupil if the pupil's postsecondary education enrollment 30 and attendance together with the pupil's attendance in either of the 31 grades 11 or 12 is at least <sup>5</sup>/<sub>6</sub> time, otherwise the pupil shall be counted 32 as that proportion of one pupil (to the nearest 1/10) that the total time of 33 the pupil's postsecondary education attendance and attendance in grade 34 11 or 12, as applicable, bears to full-time attendance. A pupil enrolled in 35 and attending an area vocational school, area vocational-technical school or approved vocational education program shall be counted as one pupil 36 37 if the pupil's vocational education enrollment and attendance together 38 with the pupil's attendance in any of grades nine through 12 is at least <sup>5</sup>/<sub>6</sub> 39 time, otherwise the pupil shall be counted as that proportion of one pupil 40(to the nearest  $\frac{1}{10}$ ) that the total time of the pupil's vocational education 41 attendance and attendance in any of grades nine through 12 bears to full-42time attendance. A pupil enrolled in a district and attending special ed-43 ucation and related services, except special education and related services

1 for preschool-aged exceptional children, provided for by the district shall be counted as one pupil. A pupil enrolled in a district and attending 2 3 special education and related services for preschool-aged exceptional children provided for by the district shall be counted as 1/2 pupil. A preschool-4 aged at-risk pupil enrolled in a district and receiving services under an  $\mathbf{5}$ approved at-risk pupil assistance plan maintained by the district shall be 6 7 counted as 1/2 pupil. A pupil in the custody of the secretary of social and 8 rehabilitation services and enrolled in unified school district No. 259, 9 Sedgwick county, Kansas, but housed, maintained, and receiving educa-10 tional services at the Judge James V. Riddel Boys Ranch, shall be counted as two pupils. 11 12(3) A pupil residing at the Flint Hills job corps center shall not be 13 counted. A pupil confined in and receiving educational services provided for by a district at a juvenile detention facility shall not be counted. A 1415 pupil enrolled in a district but housed, maintained, and receiving edu-16 cational services at a state institution shall not be counted. A pupil enrolled in a virtual school in a district but who is not a resident of the state 1718of Kansas shall not be counted. 19"Preschool-aged exceptional children" means exceptional chil- $(\mathbf{h})$ 20dren, except gifted children, who have attained the age of three years but 21are under the age of eligibility for attendance at kindergarten. (e) "At-risk pupils" means pupils who are eligible for free meals un-22

der the national school lunch act and who are engine for free means un der the national school lunch act and who are enrolled in a district which
 maintains an approved at-risk pupil assistance plan.

(c) "At-risk pupil" means a pupil whose performance is below gradelevel in either reading or mathematics as measured by the Kansas state
assessment test, the Iowa test of basic skills or other standardized test
approved by the state board of education.

(d) "Preschool-aged at-risk pupil" means an at-risk *a* pupil who has attained the age of four years, is under the age of eligibility for attendance at kindergarten, and has been selected by the state board in accordance with guidelines consonant with guidelines governing the selection of pupils for participation in head start programs.

34 "Enrollment" means: (1) (A) Subject to the provisions of para-(e) 35 graph (1)(B), for districts scheduling the school days or school hours of the school term on a trimestral or quarterly basis, the number of pupils 36 37 regularly enrolled in the district on September 20 plus the number of 38 pupils regularly enrolled in the district on February 20 less the number 39 of pupils regularly enrolled on February 20 who were counted in the 40 enrollment of the district on September 20; and for districts not specified in this paragraph (1), the number of pupils regularly enrolled in the dis-41 trict on September 20; (B) a pupil who is a foreign exchange student shall 42

43 not be counted unless such student is regularly enrolled in the district on

September 20 and attending kindergarten or any of the grades one
 through 12 maintained by the district for at least one semester or two
 quarters or the equivalent thereof;

(2) if enrollment in a district in any school year has decreased from 4 enrollment in the preceding school year, enrollment of the district in the 56 current school year means whichever is the greater of (A) enrollment in 7 the preceding school year minus enrollment in such school year of pre-8 school-aged at-risk pupils, if any such pupils were enrolled, plus enroll-9 ment in the current school year of preschool-aged at-risk pupils, if any 10 such pupils are enrolled, or (B) the sum of enrollment in the current school year of preschool-aged at-risk pupils, if any such pupils are enrolled 11 12 and the average (mean) of the sum of (i) enrollment of the district in the 13 current school year minus enrollment in such school year of preschoolaged at-risk pupils, if any such pupils are enrolled and (ii) enrollment in 1415 the preceding school year minus enrollment in such school year of pre-16 school-aged at-risk pupils, if any such pupils were enrolled and (iii) enrollment in the school year next preceding the preceding school year 1718minus enrollment in such school year of preschool-aged at-risk pupils, if 19any such pupils were enrolled; or

(3) the number of pupils as determined under K.S.A. 72-6447 or
K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 72-6448, and amendments thereto.

(f) "Adjusted enrollment" means enrollment adjusted by adding atrisk pupil weighting, program weighting, low enrollment weighting, if any, correlation weighting, if any, declining enrollment weighting, if any, school facilities weighting, if any, ancillary school facilities weighting, if any, cost of living weighting, if any, special education and related services weighting, and transportation weighting to enrollment.

(g) "At-risk pupil weighting" means an addend component assigned
 to enrollment of districts on the basis of enrollment of at-risk pupils.

(h) "Program weighting" means an addend component assigned to
enrollment of districts on the basis of pupil attendance in educational
programs which differ in cost from regular educational programs.

(i) "Low enrollment weighting" means an addend component assigned to enrollment of districts having under 1,662 enrollment on the
basis of costs attributable to maintenance of educational programs by such
districts in comparison with costs attributable to maintenance of educational programs by districts having 1,662 or over enrollment.

(j) "School facilities weighting" means an addend component as signed to enrollment of districts on the basis of costs attributable to com mencing operation of new school facilities.

41 (k) "Transportation weighting" means an addend component as-42 signed to enrollment of districts on the basis of costs attributable to the 43 provision or furnishing of transportation.

1 (1)"Cost of living weighting" means an addend component assigned 2 to enrollment of districts to which the provisions of K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 3 72-6449, and amendments thereto, apply on the basis of costs attributable 4 to the cost of living in the district. "Ancillary school facilities weighting" means an addend compo-5(m) nent assigned to enrollment of districts to which the provisions of K.S.A. 6 7 72-6441, and amendments thereto, apply on the basis of costs attributable 8 to commencing operation of new school facilities. Ancillary school facil-9 ities weighting may be assigned to enrollment of a district only if the district has levied a tax under authority of K.S.A. 72-6441, and amend-10 ments thereto, and remitted the proceeds from such tax to the state trea-11 12 surer. Ancillary school facilities weighting is in addition to assignment of 13 school facilities weighting to enrollment of any district eligible for such 14 weighting. (n) 15 "Juvenile detention facility" means: (1) Any secure public or pri-16 vate facility which is used for the lawful custody of accused or adjudicated juvenile offenders and which shall not be a jail; 17any level VI treatment facility licensed by the Kansas department 18 (2)of health and environment which is a psychiatric residential treatment 1920facility for individuals under the age of 21 which conforms with the reg-21ulations of the centers for medicare/medicaid services and the joint com-22 mission on accreditation of health care organizations governing such fa-23cilities; and 24 (3)the Forbes Juvenile Attention Facility, the Sappa Valley Youth 25Ranch of Oberlin, Salvation Army/Koch Center Youth Services, the Clar-26 ence M. Kelley Youth Center, the Clarence M. Kelley Transitional Living 27Center, Trego County Secure Care Center, St. Francis Academy at At-28chison, St. Francis Academy at Ellsworth, St. Francis Academy at Salina, 29 St. Francis Center at Salina, King's Achievement Center, and Liberty 30 Juvenile Services and Treatment. 31 "Special education and related services weighting" means an ad-32 dend component assigned to enrollment of districts on the basis of costs 33 attributable to provision of special education and related services for pu-

34 pils determined to be exceptional children.

35 "Virtual school" means any kindergarten or grades one through (p) 12 course offered for credit that uses distance-learning technologies 36 37 which predominantly use internet-based methods to deliver instruction 38 and for which the course content is available on an "anytime, anyplace" 39 basis, but the instruction occurs asynchronously with the teacher and pupil in separate locations, not necessarily located within a local education 4041agency. (q) "Declining enrollment weighting" means an addend component 42

42 (q) Deciming enrolment weighting means an addend component 43 assigned to enrollment of districts to which the provisions of K.S.A. 2005

Supp. 72-6451, and amendments thereto, apply on the basis of reduced
 revenues attributable to the declining enrollment of the district.

3 (r) "Correlation weighting" means an addend component assigned to 4 enrollment of districts having 1,662 or over enrollment on the basis of

costs attributable to maintenance of educational programs by such dis-tricts as a correlate to low enrollment weighting assigned to enrollment

7 of districts having under 1,662 enrollment.
