9 AN ACT concerning the minimum wage and maximum hours law; in-10creasing the minimum wage; amending K.S.A. 44-1203 and repealing the existing section. 11 1213 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 44-1203 is hereby amended to read as follows: 44-14 151203. (a) Except as otherwise provided in the minimum wage and maxi-16 mum hours law, every employer shall pay to each employee wages at a rate of not less than \$2.65 \$5.15 an hour. In calculating such minimum 17wage rate, an employer may include tips and gratuities received by an 18employee in an amount equal to not more than 40% of the minimum 1920 wage rate if such tips and gratuities have customarily constituted part of 21the remuneration of the employee and if the employee concerned actually 22received and retained such tips and gratuities. The secretary shall require each employer desiring approval of an allowance for gratuities to provide 23 substantial evidence of the amounts of such gratuities on account of which 2425the employer has taken an allowance pursuant to this section. 26(b) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any employers 27 and employees who are covered under the provisions of section 6 of the fair labor standards act of 1938 as amended (29 U.S.C.A. § 206), and as 2829amended by the fair labor standards amendments of 1974 and any other 30 acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto. 31 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 44-1203 is hereby repealed. 32 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 33 publication in the statute book.
