## **HOUSE BILL No. 2797**

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AN ACT concerning the attorney general; establishing a statewide workers compensation fraud and abuse telephone hotline; creating the position of workers compensation fraud and abuse investigator.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The attorney general shall establish and maintain a statewide workers compensation fraud and abuse telephone hotline within the office of the attorney general. The workers compensation fraud and abuse telephone hotline shall be a toll-free telephone connection that is available for use by members of the general public, specifically including employers and employees that are under the workers compensation act, throughout the state. The hotline shall be for the purpose of receiving complaints and other information regarding instances of alleged fraud or fraudulent or abusive acts or practices, or other violations of K.S.A. 44-5,120 through 44-5,125 and amendments thereto, or any other acts, practices or violations that constitute crimes. The attorney general shall publicize the existence and purpose of the statewide workers compensation fraud and abuse telephone hotline throughout the state.

- (b) There is hereby established the position of workers compensation fraud and abuse investigator in the office of the attorney general. The workers compensation fraud and abuse investigator shall be in the unclassified service under the Kansas civil service act. In addition to other duties and functions assigned by the attorney general, the workers compensation fraud and abuse investigator shall investigate complaints and other information regarding instances of alleged fraud or fraudulent or abusive acts or practices, or other violations of K.S.A. 44-5,120 through 44-5,125 and amendments thereto, or any other acts, practices or violations that constitute crimes.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
