9 AN ACT concerning real property; relating to home inspections; requir-10 ing home inspector registration and certification; requiring insurance. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. (a) As used in this section: 14(1)"Home inspection" means a noninvasive visual examination of the 15 mechanical, electrical and plumbing systems, and the structural and es-16sential components of a residential dwelling or any portion thereof de-17signed to identify material defects in those systems and components and 18performed for a fee in connection with or preparation for a proposed or 19possible residential real estate transfer. The term also includes any consultation regarding the property that is represented to be a home inspec-2021tion or that is described by any similar term. 22 (2)"Home inspection report" means a written report on the results 23 of a home inspection. 24 (3)"Home inspector" means an individual who performs a home 25inspection. 26(b) On and after January 1, 2007, all home inspectors in this state 27 shall be registered with the board of technical professions pursuant to 28rules and regulations adopted by the board. The board shall fix by rules 29 and regulations an annual fee for such registration so as to cover all or 30 part of the costs of registration. 31(c) (1) On and after January 1, 2008, all registered home inspectors 32 performing services in counties with 50,000 or more residents shall be 33 certified by the American society of home inspectors (ASHI) or other 34 recognized organization of home inspectors. 35 (2) On and after January 1, 2009, all registered home inspectors per-36 forming services in counties between 20,000 and 50,000 residents shall 37 be certified by the American society of home inspectors (ASHI) or other 38 recognized organization of home inspectors. 39 On and after January 1, 2010, all registered home inspectors per-(3)40 forming services in counties with 20,000 or fewer residents shall be cer-41tified by the American society of home inspectors (ASHI) or other rec-42ognized organization of home inspectors. 43 (d) On and after January 1, 2007, home inspectors shall carry a min-

- 1 imum of \$500,000 errors and omissions insurance coverage.
