9 AN ACT relating to the commission on emergency planning and re-10 sponse; concerning the membership; amending K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 65-5721 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 65-5721 is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 65-5721. (a) On the effective date of this order, there is hereby 16 established the commission on emergency planning and response. 17The membership of the commission on emergency planning and (b) 18response shall consist of the agency head or secretary or a designated person of authority from the following agencies: 1920(1)the fire marshal; 21(2)the department of health and environment; (3)22 the department of transportation; 23 (4)the Kansas highway patrol; 24 (5)the adjutant general; and 25(6)the department of commerce. 26 (c) In addition, the membership of the commission on emergency 27 planning and response shall also consist of seven 18 members appointed 28by the governor as follows: 29 (1)Two individuals shall be representative of counties; 30 (2)two individuals selected to represent cities; and 31 (3)three individuals selected to represent businesses and industries; 32 (4)one individual selected to represent agriculture, crop or livestock; 33 (5)two individuals selected to represent transportation, trucking and 34 rail; one individual selected to represent energy; 35 (6)(7)36 one individual selected to represent law enforcement officers; 37 (8)one individual selected to represent fire fighters; 38 (9)one individual selected to represent county emergency managers; 39 (10)one individual selected to represent emergency medical services; 40 (11)one individual selected to represent public works services; 41(12)one individual selected to represent hospitals; and 42(13)one individual selected to represent public health. 43 (d) A designee of the adjutant general shall serve as the secretary of 1 the commission on emergency planning and response. The adjutant gen-

2 eral shall provide staff support for the commission on emergency planning3 and response.

(e) Of the members first appointed to the commission on emergency 4 planning and response by the governor, one representative of cities, one 5representative of counties, and one representative of business and indus-6 7 try shall serve a term of two years, and the remainder of the members 8 appointed by the governor shall serve terms of three years. Thereafter, 9 members who represent cities, counties, and business and industry, agriculture, transportation, energy, law enforcement officers, fire fighters, 10 county emergency managers, emergency medical service, public works 11 12service, hospitals and public health shall serve terms of four years and 13 until the successor has been appointed. Any vacancy in the office of an appointed member shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment 1415 by the governor. (f) A chairperson shall be elected annually by the members of the 16

16 (f) A chairperson shall be elected annually by the members of the 17 commission. A vice-chairperson shall be designated by the chairperson to 18 serve in the absence of the chairperson.

(g) For attending meetings of such commission, or attending a subcommittee meeting thereof authorized by such commission, those members of the commission appointed by the governor shall be paid compensation, subsistence allowances, mileage and other expenses as provided
