(a) (1) Words and phrases used in this section shall have 13 the meanings ascribed thereto by K.S.A. 25-4143, and amendments 14thereto. 15 "Industrial revenue bonds" means bonds issued pursuant to (2)16K.S.A. 12-1740 et seq., and amendments thereto. (3) "Tax abatement" means the abatement of any ad valorem prop-1718erty tax granted pursuant to law. 19(b) (1) No person, other than an individual, which received a tax 20abatement shall make a contribution to a candidate, candidate committee 21or political committee. 22 (2) No candidate, candidate committee or political committee know-23 ingly shall solicit or accept a contribution from any person, other than an individual, which received a tax abatement. 24 25(3) The prohibitions of this subsection shall apply in the tax year in 26which the abatement is granted and in the five tax years thereafter. 27No person, other than an individual, which received financing (c) (1)28through the issuance of industrial revenue bonds shall make a contribu-29 tion to a candidate, candidate committee or political committee. 30 No candidate, candidate committee or political committee know-(2)ingly shall solicit or accept a contribution from any person, other than an 3132 individual, which received financing through the issuance of industrial 33 revenue bonds. 34 (3) The prohibitions of this subsection shall apply during the period 35 for which there are any outstanding industrial revenue bonds. 36 Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be subject to (d) 37 the penalties prescribed by K.S.A. 25-4181, and amendments thereto. 38 (e) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the campaign 39 finance act. 40 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 41publication in the statute book.
