9 AN ACT concerning teachers; relating to licensure; amending K.S.A. 10 2005 Supp. 72-1388 and repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 72-1388 is hereby amended to read as 14follows: 72-1388. (a) The state board of education, in accordance with 15law, is authorized to adopt rules and regulations providing for the issu-16 ance, renewal, reinstatement and registration of licenses for teachers and 17other personnel in the state department of education and in schools and 18institutions under the general supervision of the state board of education. 19(b) In addition to *any* other requirements and subject to the provi-20sions of K.S.A. 72-1396, and amendments thereto, the rules and regula-21tions of the state board of education shall include after May 1, 1986, the 22 requirement that applicants for initial issuance of licenses to teach shall 23 take and satisfactorily pass an examination prescribed by the state board. 24 In addition to any other requirements and subject to the provisions (c)25of K.S.A. 72-1396, and amendments thereto, the rules and regulations of 26the state board of education shall include a requirement that: 27(1)Applicants for initial issuance of licenses to teach shall have com-28pleted at least two credit hours in bilingual/multi-cultural education, Eng-29 lish as a second language or English for speakers of other languages; and 30 applicants for renewal of licenses who do not have previous credit (2)31in the area of bilingual/multi-cultural education, English as a second lan-32 guage or English for speakers of other languages shall have completed a 33 two-hour survey course or other courses with equivalent content in such 34 areas. 35 The privilege to teach at any level or in any field or subject, if (c) 36 such privilege is or has been granted when a license is issued, may not 37 be withheld during the term for which the license is issued except as 38 provided in K.S.A. 72-1383 or 72-5412, and amendments to such sections. 39 Sec. 2.
