- Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
- Section 1. This act shall be cited as the umbilical cord donation information act.
- Sec. 2. (a) All health care providers providing health care services to a pregnant woman during the last trimester of such pregnancy, which health care services are directly related to such pregnancy, shall advise such person of options to donate an umbilical cord following the delivery of a newborn child. Provision in a timely manner of publications prepared by the department of health and environment pursuant to subsection (b) shall constitute compliance with this subsection.
- The department of health and environment shall, by July 1, 2006, prepare and distribute to health care providers information that includes the following:
- (1)The medical processes involved in the collection of umbilical cords;
- the medical risks to a mother and the newborn child of umbilical (2)cord collection;
- the current and potential future medical uses and benefits of umbilical cord collection to the birth mother, the newborn child and the biological family;
- the current and potential future medical uses and benefits of umbilical cord collection to persons who are not biologically related to the birth mother or the newborn child;
- any costs that may be incurred by a pregnant woman who chooses to make an umbilical cord donation;
 - options for ownership and future use of the donated material; and
- 39 the availability in this state of umbilical cord donations.
- 40 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
