9 AN ACT concerning electric transmission facilities; providing for the cre-10 ation of an independent transmission company in this state. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. (a) As used in this section: 14(1)"Appurtenances" means all substations, towers, poles and other 15structures and equipment necessary for the bulk transfer of electricity. 16"Commission" means the state corporation commission. (2)17(3)"Electric transmission line" means any line or extension of a line 18with an operating voltage of 34.5 kilovolts or more which is at least five 19miles in length and which is used for the bulk transfer of electricity. 20(4)"Transmission facilities" means electric transmission lines and 21appurtenances. 22 Not later than August 1, 2006, the commission shall issue a re-(b) 23 quest for proposals for an independent transmission company to manage 24 and operate all transmission facilities in this state. The request for pro-25posal shall require that, to be selected to operate the independent trans-26 mission company, a person or entity at a minimum must: 27 (1)Demonstrate financial and management ability to manage and 28operate all transmission facilities in this state; 29 demonstrate ability to interact with and participate in proceedings (2)30 involving the southwest power pool, the federal energy regulatory com-31mission, electric transmission interests outside this state, the Kansas leg-32 islature and the commission; 33 (3)demonstrate ability to provide the authorized rate of return to 34 electric transmission line owners who place transmission facilities in a 35 trust: 36 demonstrate ability to determine the need for and location of new (4)37 transmission facilities coordinate and schedule transmission service; and 38 (5)demonstrate ability to serve the transmission requirements of re-39 newable energy, fossil fuel and nuclear power generators. 40 Not later than December 31, 2006, the commission shall select (c) 41the winning proposal for an independent transmission company to man-42age and operate all transmission facilities in this state. 43 (d) On the earliest possible date, as determined by the commission,

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1 all operators of transmission facilities in this state shall transfer opera-

2 tional control of such transmission facilities to the independent transmis-3 sion company and shall sell them to the independent transmission com-

pany selected by the commission or place them in a trust under which 4

the trustee has full discretion over the transmission facilities. 5

The independent transmission company shall: (e)

7 (1)Solicit load and demand forecasts from all generators located within the area served by the company; 8

9 (2) have authority to disapprove proposed sites for new generation facilities when determined necessary to maximize benefits to all Kansas 10 consumers through cost-effective use of transmission lines; 11

(3) brief the Kansas electric transmission authority each year on op-1213 erations and plans of the company;

implement, not later than January 1, 2012, a postage stamp system 14(4)15 of fees providing a single charge for access to transmission facilities operated by the company; and 16

perform such other duties and functions as necessary to operate 17(5)18and maintain all transmission facilities in this state.

An operator of transmission facilities outside this state may par-19(f) 20ticipate in the independent transmission company created pursuant to this section upon a determination by the commission that the operator's 2122

participation will benefit Kansas consumers.
