## HOUSE BILL No. 2930

9 AN ACT concerning wildlife and parks; relating to the qualifications of 10 the secretary; amending K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 32-801 and repealing the 11existing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 32-801 is hereby amended to read as 15 follows: 32-801. (a) In order to reorganize the administration, planning 16 and regulation of the state's parks, wildlife and other natural resources, 17there is hereby established within the executive branch of government 18the Kansas department of wildlife and parks, which shall be administered 19under the direction and supervision of a secretary of wildlife and parks 20who shall be appointed by the governor, with the consent of the senate 21as provided in K.S.A. 75-4315b and amendments thereto. 22 The secretary shall be fully qualified by education, training and (b) 23 experience in wildlife, parks or natural resources, or a related field, and 24 shall have a demonstrated executive and administrative ability to discharge the duties of the office of secretary. The secretary shall serve at 2526 the pleasure of the governor. The secretary shall be in the unclassified 27 service under the Kansas civil service act and shall receive an annual salary 28to be fixed by the governor. 29 (c) The provisions of the Kansas governmental operations accounta-30 bility law apply to the Kansas department of wildlife and parks, and the 31 department is subject to audit, review and evaluation under such law. 32 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 32-801 is hereby repealed. 33 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 34 publication in the statute book.
