AN ACT concerning landlords and tenants; relating to tenants who are

10 victims of crime. 11 12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. (a) If a tenant is the victim of a felony offense or misdemeanor theft in an amount of \$500 or more, the tenant may terminate a 14 15 rental agreement. Unless the rental agreement is a week-to-week tenancy, 16 the tenant shall give written notice to the landlord stating that the tenancy 17 shall terminate upon the periodic rent-paying date not less than 30 days 18 after the receipt of the notice. A copy of the police report shall accompany 19 the termination notice. 20

- (b) If the rental agreement is terminated, the landlord shall return that portion of the security deposit recoverable by the tenant under K.S.A. 58-2550, and amendments thereto.
- (c) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the residential landlord and tenant act.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
