9 AN ACT concerning prescription drugs, creating the prescription privacy 10 act. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the prescrip-14tion privacy act. 15 Sec. 2. (a) Information that identifies a specific prescriber or patient 16on a prescription shall not be transferred by any pharmacy, pharmacy 17benefits manager, insurance provider, data transfer intermediary or their 18agents. 19(b) If no payment is received for the disclosure, information that 20identifies a specific prescriber or patient on a prescription may be re-21leased to: 22(1)The patient for whom the original prescription was issued; 23 a licensed prescriber who issued the prescription or who treats (2)24 the patient; 25an officer, inspector or investigator for a government health, li-(3)26 censing or law enforcement agency; 27 a person authorized by a court order to receive the information; (4)28(5)a pharmacy or medical researcher who has written authorization 29 signed by the patient or the patient's legal guardian to receive such 30 information; 31(6) another pharmacy, for the limited purpose of preventing individ-32 uals from misusing or falsifying prescription forms to illegally obtain ex-33 cessive or unauthorized drugs; and 34 (7) the patient's insurance provider or the provider's agent, for the 35 limited purpose of reimbursing the pharmacy. 36 (c) This section shall be enforced by the secretary of health and environment, who shall promulgate such rules and regulations as are nec-37 38 essary to implement and administer compliance with this act. 39 If any person violates this section, the secretary of health and environ-40 ment may bring an action in court for injunctive relief, costs, attorneys' 41fees and a civil penalty of up to \$1,000 per violation. Each unlawful dis-42closure shall constitute a separate violation. 43
