9 AN ACT concerning limitations on testamentary power; amending 10K.S.A. 59-602 and repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 59-602 is hereby amended to read as follows: 59-14602. (a) Any devise or other disposition of real estate located in this state 15 taking effect in possession or enjoyment at death, and any bequest or 16 other disposition of any personal property by a resident of this state taking 17effect in possession or enjoyment at death, without regard to the time 18when the will or other instrument containing such devise, bequest or 19other such disposition shall have been made, to any foreign country, subdivision thereof, or city, body politic, or corporation, located therein or 2021existing under the laws thereof, or in trust or otherwise to any trustee or 22 agent thereof, except devises, bequests or other such dispositions to in-23 stitutions created and existing exclusively for religious, educational, or 24 charitable purposes, is hereby prohibited. Any such devise, bequest or 25other such disposition shall be void. 26(b) Except as may be authorized under K.S.A. 39-785 to 39-790, in-27clusive, and amendments thereto, or is authorized under federal law, any 28devise or other disposition of real estate located in this state which is made 29 or entered into on or after the effective date of this act, and any bequest 30 or other disposition of any personal property by a resident of this state 31which is made or entered into on or after the effective date of this act to 32 any person, or in trust or otherwise to any trustee or agent thereof which 33 is made or entered into on or after the effective date of this act, which is 34 intended to result in making an individual eligible for public assistance, 35 as the term assistance is defined under K.S.A. 39-702 and amendments 36 thereto, is hereby prohibited. Any such devise, bequest or other such dis-37 position shall be void. 38 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 59-602 is hereby repealed. 39 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

40 publication in the statute book.
