12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Trafficking in counterfeit drugs is intentionally manufacturing, distributing, dispensing, selling or delivering for consumption
purposes, or holding or offering for sale, any counterfeit drug.

16 (b) Trafficking in counterfeit drugs which have a retail value of less 17 than \$500 is a class A nonperson misdemeanor, trafficking in counterfeit 18 drugs which have a retail value of at least \$500 but less than \$25,000 is a

19 severity level 9, nonperson felony and trafficking in counterfeit drugs

20 which have a retail value of \$25,000 or more is a severity level 7, non-

21 person felony.

(c) A pharmacy which is inadvertently in possession of counterfeit
drugs may return those drugs to the supplier who provided the drugs to
the pharmacy.

25 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 26 publication in the statute book.
