9 AN ACT concerning fire protection; exempting certain buildings from certain fire protection statutes or rules and regulations enforced by the state fire marshal.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of article 1 of chapter 31 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, or any acts amendatory or supplemental thereto, or any other provision of law to the contrary, each canopy open air exhibition or agricultural building of non-combustible construction which is less than 70,000 square feet located on the grounds of the Kansas state fair shall be exempt from the provisions of subsection (a)(3) of K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 31-133, and amendments thereto, and any other statute or rule and regulation adopted by the state fire marshal that would require that a sprinkler system be installed if a fire alarm system and exit and emergency lighting are installed in compliance with the Kansas fire prevention code.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
