36 37 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, the owner of any duly registered and licensed farm truck or truck tractor in this state, engaged in the transporting of unfinished and unprocessed forest products, logs, ties, stave bolts and posts, originating and produced by such owner, from the point of production or harvesting to the point at which they shall first undergo any processing, preparation for processing, conversion or transformation from their raw or natural state, and desiring to operate in intrastate commerce in this state for a temporary period only, may obtain a timber permit, authorizing the operation of such farm truck or truck tractor on the highways of this state for a period of not to exceed 90 days from the date of issuance of such permit. The fee for each such permit shall be \$26. Where such fee is paid on a farm truck or truck tractor, no registration or fee shall be required for a trailer or semitrailer duly registered in this or another state and propelled by such farm truck or truck tractor. Application for such timber permit shall be made to the division of vehicles of the department of revenue.

- (b) Any person issued a timber permit under this section, shall be authorized to operate such farm truck or truck tractor within 150 air miles of any farm or farms owned or leased by the registered owner of such farm truck or truck tractor.
- (c) The secretary of revenue may adopt rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this section.
- $\left(d\right)$. The provisions of this section shall be a part of and supplemental to K.S.A. 8-126 et seq., and amendments thereto.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
