9 AN ACT concerning certain electric power plants; limiting mercury 10emissions. 1112Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. (a) As used in this section: "Affected unit" means any emissions unit which generates elec-14(1)15 tricity in this state and combusts coal in an amount greater than 10% of 16 its total heat input on a rolling 12-month basis and which is a new unit, 17or is an existing unit that requires a new construction permit pursuant to 18rules and regulations of the secretary. 19 "Inlet conditions" means the concentration of mercury in the flue (2)20gas exiting the combustion source prior to application of any air pollution 21control device. 22 (3)"Mercury" means mercury and mercury compounds in either a 23 gaseous or particulate form. 24 (b) The secretary of health and environment shall adopt rules and 25regulations requiring affected units to achieve 80% or greater reduction 26 of mercury from the measured inlet condition of the affected unit. 27 (c) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas air 28 quality act. 29 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 30 publication in the statute book.
