9	AN ACT concerning legal public holidays; amending K.S.A. 2005 Supp.
10	35-107 and repealing the existing section.

12	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
13	Section 1. On and after January 1, 2007, K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 35-107
14	is hereby amended to read as follows: 35-107. (a) On and after January
15	1, 2006, The following days are declared to be legal public holidays and
16	are to be observed as such:
17	New Year's Day, January 1;
18	Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, the third Monday in January;
19	President's Day, the third Monday in February;
20	Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;
21	Independence Day, July 4;
22	Labor Day, the first Monday in September;
23	Columbus Day, the second Monday in October;
24	Veterans' Day, the eleventh day in November 11;
25	Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November;
26	Christmas Day, December 25.
27	(b) If a day declared as a legal holiday by subsection (a) falls on a
28	Saturday, the Friday immediately before is the legal holiday. If a day
29	declared as a legal holiday by subsection (a) falls on a Sunday, the Monday
30	immediately after is the legal holiday.
31	(c) Any reference in the laws of this state concerning observance of
32	legal holidays shall on and after January 1, 2006, be considered as a
33	reference to the day or days prescribed in subsection (a) for the obser-
34	vance of such legal holiday or holidays.
35	(d) All state departments and agencies, including the legislature and
36	its agencies, shall observe the holidays provided by this section and no
37	agency shall have authority to change any such holiday by rules and
38	regulations or otherwise.
39	Sec. 2. On and after January 1, 2007, K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 35-107 is
40	hereby repealed.
41	Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
42	publication in the statute book.
