AN ACT regulating traffic; concerning [video or] television-type receiv-10 11 ing equipment; amending K.S.A. 8-1748 and repealing the existing 12 section. 13 14 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 15 Section 1. K.S.A. 8-1748 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-16 1748. (a) No motor vehicle operated on the highways of this state shall 17 be equipped with television-type receiving equipment so located that the 18 viewer or screen is visible from the driver's seat The operation of any 19 [video or] television-type receiving equipment by any person in a moving 20 motor vehicle shall be unlawful, if the viewer or screen of such equipment 21 is so located that it is visible from the driver's seat. 22 (b) This section does not prohibit: (1) The use of television-type re-23 ceiving equipment used exclusively for safety or law enforcement pur-24 poses, if such use is approved by the superintendent of the Kansas high-25 way patrol; or (2) electronic displays used in conjunction with vehicle 26 navigation systems. 27 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-1748 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
