(a) Each complaint alleging a violation of any election 13 crime set forth in article 24 of chapter 25 of the Kansas Statutes Anno-14 tated, and amendments thereto, received by a county election officer shall 15 be reported to the secretary of state on a form provided by the secretary 16 of state. Each report shall be made in writing within 30 days after re-17 ceiving the complaint.

(b) The secretary of state shall develop the reporting form required
by subsection (a) and distribute copies thereof to each county election
official on or before October 1, 2006.

(c) Upon conviction of any person for violating any provision of article
24 of chapter 25 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments
thereto, the clerk of the district court shall notify the secretary of state of
such conviction.

(d) For the purposes of this section, "county election officer" shall
have the meaning ascribed to it in K.S.A. 25-2504 and amendments
thereto.
