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9 AN ACT concerning medicaid; relating to payroll agents for certain cli-10ents; care services by family members; concerning a waiver for home and community based services programs. 11 1213 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2006, as part of the Kansas 14 medicaid home and community based services program, payroll agents 1516 for clients who self-direct their own care services shall be selected through a process established by the agency administering such a 17program. 18(b) (1) Under the Kansas medicaid home and community based serv-1920ices program, family members of clients who self-direct their own care 21services may provide services to such clients but shall not be reimbursed 22 more than 75% of the regular reimbursement rate for such services. To 23 be eligible for reimbursement the family member must be 18 years of 24age or older. 25(2)As used in this subsection, "family member" means: 26 (A) A parent, child or sibling; 27a sibling, as denoted by the prefix "half"; (B) 28 $(\mathbf{C})$ a parent, child or sibling, as denoted by the prefix "step"; 29 (D) a foster child; 30  $(\mathbf{E})$ an uncle, aunt, nephew or niece; any parent or child of a preceding or subsequent generation, as 31  $(\mathbf{F})$ 32 denoted by the prefix of "grand" or "great"; or a parent, child or sibling related by marriage as denoted by the 33  $(\mathbf{G})$ 34 suffix of "in-law." 35 Sec. 2. The Kansas health policy authority shall seek a waiver from the federal department of health and human services to allow home and 36 37 community based services clients to choose services and service providers 38 and self-direct such services. 39 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 40publication in the statute book.
