AN ACT concerning the Kansas offender registration act; relating to res-11 12idency restrictions.

14Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

15Section 1. (a) It shall be unlawful for an offender to reside within 162,000 feet of a licensed child care facility, registered family day care home 17or the real property of any school upon which is located a structure used by a unified school district or an accredited nonpublic school for student 18instruction or attendance or extracurricular activities of pupils enrolled in 1920kindergarten or any grades one through 12. 21

Violation of this section is a class A nonperson misdemeanor. (b)

This section shall not apply to any of the following: (c)

23 An offender who is serving a sentence at any state correctional (1)24 institution or facility, conservation camp, state security hospital, juvenile 25correctional facility, community correction center or facility for detention 26or confinement, juvenile detention facility or jail.

27 (2)An offender who is subject to an order of commitment pursuant 28to K.S.A. 59-29a01 et seq., and amendments thereto.

29 An offender who has established a residence prior to July 1, 2006, (3)30 or a school, registered family day care home or licensed child care facility 31 is newly located on or after July 1, 2006.

(4)An offender who is a minor or a ward under a guardianship.

33 (d) For purposes of this section:

34 "Offender" means a person who is an offender as defined in (1)

35 K.S.A. 22-4902, and amendments thereto, and the criminal conviction which requires the offender to register was against a victim or involved a 36 37 party who was less than 18 years of age.

38 "Residence" means the place where a person sleeps, which may (2)39 include more than one location, and may be mobile or transitory.

40 This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas of-(e) 41fender registration act.

42Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 43 publication in the statute book.
