AN ACT concerning criminal history records; authorizing fingerprints and criminal history of applicants and current holders of any license, registration, permit or certificate issued by the state board of healing arts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The state board of healing arts may require an applicant for any license, registration, permit or certificate or any individual who currently holds any license, registration, permit or certificate issued by the state board of healing arts to be fingerprinted and submit to a national criminal history record check for the purpose of determining initial or continuing qualifications and suitability to obtain or maintain a license, registration, permit or certificate. The fingerprints shall be used to identify the applicant or holder of the license, registration, permit or certificate and to determine whether the applicant or holder of the license, registration, permit or certificate has a record of criminal arrests and convictions in this state or other jurisdictions. The state board of healing arts is authorized to submit the fingerprints to the Kansas bureau of investigation and the federal bureau of investigation for a state and national criminal history record check. The state board of healing arts may use the information obtained from fingerprinting and the criminal history of the applicant or holder of the license, registration, permit or certificate only for purposes of verifying the identification of any applicant or holder and in the official determination of qualifications and suitability to be issued or to maintain a license, registration, permit or certificate issued by the board.

- (b) The state board of healing arts shall have access to any court orders or adjudications of any court of record, any records of such orders, adjudications, arrests, nonconvictions, convictions, expungements, juvenile records, juvenile expungements, diversions and any criminal history record information in the possession of the Kansas bureau of investigation concerning applicants or holders of a license, registration, permit or certificate issued by the board.
- (c) Local and state law enforcement officers and agencies shall assist the state board of healing arts in taking and processing of fingerprints of

 applicants for any license, registration, permit or certificate or individuals who currently hold any license, registration, permit or certificate issued by the state board of healing arts and shall release all records of the arrests and convictions of an applicant or holder of a license, registration, permit or certificate to the state board of healing arts.

- (d) Fees for such record checks shall be assessed to the state board of healing arts, provided, however, the state board of healing arts may charge and collect in advance the fees from the applicant or holder of a license, registration, permit or certificate for whom the criminal history is obtained.
- (e) Disclosure or use of any such information received by the state board of healing arts or of any record containing such information, for any purpose other than that provided by this act is a class A misdemeanor and shall constitute grounds for removal from office or termination of employment. Nothing in this act shall be construed to make unlawful or prohibit the disclosure of any such information in an administrative or court proceeding relating to the qualifications and suitability of a person to obtain or maintain any license, registration, permit or certificate issued by the state board of healing arts.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
