(a) There is hereby established the Kansas technical col-17lege and vocational education school commission, which shall be composed of seven the following members appointed as follows: 1819 (1) One member shall be a member of the state board of regents and 20shall be selected by the state board of regents; 21one member shall be a member of the governing board of a Kan-(2)22 sas technical college *president* and shall be selected by the state board 23 of regents; 24 (3) one member shall be a person selected by the governor who shall 25serve as chairperson of the commission; and 26(4) the speaker and minority leader of the house of representatives 27and the president and minority leader of the senate shall each select one 28member of the commission .; and 29 The president of the board of regents shall be an ex-officio, (5) 30 nonvoting member of the commission. 31 (b) In making such selections, the governor and legislative lead-32 ers shall give consideration to persons representing businesses, in-33 dustry, and instructional staff of such schools and colleges. 34 $(\mathbf{b} \mathbf{c})$ The commission shall undertake a study of the governance, 35 funding **performance** and the mission of Kansas technical colleges and 36 vocational education schools. The commission shall review and con-37 sider recommendations of the board of regents. 38 (e d) On or before January 1, 2007, the commission shall submit its 39 first report of the commission's activities and legislative recommenda-40 tions regarding governance, funding **performance** and the mission of 41Kansas technical colleges and vocational education schools. On or before 42January 1, 2008, the commission shall submit its final report on such

43 matters and legislative recommendations. The commission shall be

8 (f) Staff <u>assistance shall</u> resources of the state board of regents 9 shall be provided to the commission and coordinated by the state

11 office of the revisor of statutes, the legislative research department

12 and the division of legislative administrative services as may be

13 directed by the legislative coordinating council.
