9 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging support of "25 by 25". 10WHEREAS, Having an affordable, reliable and plentiful energy sup-11 12ply is critical to our economy, as well as our national and international 13 food supply; and 14 WHEREAS, Current and future risks to the United States energy security are mounting while domestic and global energy demands are grow-1516 ing exponentially; and 17WHEREAS, Kansas and the midwest have tremendous renewable energy resources; and 18WHEREAS, The development of a broad spectrum of renewable en-1920ergy sources, including wind power, biodiesel, biomass, methane digest-21ers, ethanol and solar, benefits the environment and will have a direct 22economic benefit to agricultural landowners and rural communities; and 23WHEREAS, Rural communities and agriculture sectors will experience multiple benefits, including establishing additional markets for ag-24 25ricultural commodities, increasing farm income, creating added-value 26 uses for crops, livestock and their byproducts, more productive use of 27marginal lands, the resolution of air, water and soil quality problems that 28may arise from agricultural operations, improving wildlife habitat and 29 creating many new job opportunities; and 30 WHEREAS, Solar and wind energy can be captured on the vast land 31 areas managed by the United States agriculture and technology and pro-32 duction capabilities allow America's farmers and ranchers to play a major 33 role in ensuring a fully sustainable United States energy system; and 34 WHEREAS, American agriculture is well positioned to play an ex-35 panded role in the development and implementation of new energy solutions and with appropriate technological innovation, incentives and in-36 37 vestments, America's farms and ranches can become the factories that 38 produce a new generation of fuels to help meet the nation's energy needs; 39 and 40 WHEREAS, "25 by 25" is an agriculturally led initiative that envisions America's farms and ranches producing 25% of America's energy demand 41 by the year 2025 while continuing to produce abundant, safe and afford-42

43 able food and fiber; and

1 WHEREAS, Agriculture's role as an energy producer will have a pos-2 itive effect on national security and trade imbalances, and will serve as a З catalyst for rural development in Kansas: Now, therefore, Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Kansas, the House of Rep-4 $\mathbf{5}$ resentatives concurring therein: That the legislature of the state of Kan-6 sas supports the vision of "25 by 25" whereby agriculture will provide 725% of the total energy consumed in the United States by the year 2025, 8 while continuing to produce abundant, safe and affordable food and fiber. 9 Be it further resolved: That the Secretary of State be directed to send enrolled copies of this resolution to the President of the United States; 10Majority Leader and Minority Leader of the United States Senate; the 11 Speaker, Majority Leader and Minority Leader of the United States 12 13 House of Representatives, and to each member of the Kansas Congressional Delegation. 14
