9 AN ACT concerning consumer protection; relating to automatic 10renewals. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. (a) No supplier shall include any provision in a consumer 14contract providing for the automatic renewal of such contract for an ad-15 ditional period of one year or more unless the supplier gives written notice 16 by personal service or certified mail to the consumer at least 30 days but 17not more than 60 days prior to the date the contract is scheduled for 18renewal. (b) 19Such written notice shall: 20(1)Be separate from any billing or other regular mailing sent by the 21supplier; 22 specifically reference the existence of the automatic renewal pro-(2)23 vision in the contract; 24 specify any action the consumer must take to notify the supplier (3)25of the consumer's intention not to renew; and 26(4)provide the correct mailing address and telephone number of the 27 supplier. 28(c) Any consumer contract that does not conform to this section is 29 voidable by the consumer. 30 (d) Violation of this section is an unconscionable act of practice under 31the Kansas consumer protection act. 32 (e) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas con-33 sumer protection act. 34 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 35 publication in the statute book.
